

September 2021 Quarterly Compliance Report

Understanding the Administrator's Quarterly Compliance Report

Clause B102 of the *National Health Reform Agreement 2011* (the Agreement) requires the Administrator to publish details of Commonwealth, State and Territory compliance with the data requirements specified in the <u>Administrator's Three Year Data Plan 2021-22 to 2023-24</u>. Clause A152 of the *Addendum to the National Health Reform Agreement 2020-21 to 2024-25* (the Addendum) requires the Administrator to publish additional information in the compliance reports.

The format of the Quarterly Compliance Reports follows a standard structure, with relevant data requirements reflected in each quarter. Further information on requirements can be found in the Administrator's 2021-22 Data Compliance Policy.

Executive Summary

Five out of eight States and Territories have submitted 2021-22 Service Agreements to the Administrator. Western Australia provided interim Agreements to the Administrator ahead of their delayed 2021-22 Budget and will provide updated Service Agreements later in the 2021 calendar year. The Australian Capital Territory are also delayed in providing their Service Agreement due to the deferral of their 2021-22 Budget. Victoria are yet to provide any 2021-22 Service Agreements and provided their 2020-21 Service Agreements after the 2020-21 financial year concluded.

Following engagement with States and Territories on consistency and transparency of public hospital funding, 39 of the 44 Service Agreements submitted to the Administrator align to current data estimate submissions. There is further work to do on the consistency of Service Agreements with a significant number of Service Agreements missing required information.

Timeliness of data submissions to support the 2020-21 Annual Reconciliation have improved on the prior year with six out of eight States and Territories providing Submission A files on time, and six of eight providing Submission B files on time. However only seven of eight Statements of Assurance were provided, with only two received on time.

Monthly reporting continues to be completed by States and Territories on or before the due date of the 15th of the following month.

The Administrator will continue to work with States on providing greater transparency and consistency of public reporting throughout 2021-22, including through the Quarterly Compliance Report.


