² In order to calculate growth in Commonwealth contributions, the Administrator's Data Plan requires states to provide NWAU estimates by service category, by LHN. Victoria provided estimated NWAU by service category and by LHN separately, but not service category by LHN.

³ Under the *National Health Reform Agreement*, states and territories are required to provide the Administrator with a copy of the annual Service Agreement they enter into with each of their LHNs, once agreed. The values shown above indicate the number of 2013-14 Service Agreements that have been provided to the Administrator as a proportion of the total number of LHNs.
