

September 2020 Quarterly Compliance Report

Understanding the Administrator's Quarterly Compliance Report

Clause B102 of the National Health Reform Agreement 2011 requires the Administrator to publish details of Commonwealth, State and Territory compliance with the data requirements specified in the Administrator's Three Year Data Plan 2020-21 to 2022-23. Clause A152 of the Addendum to the National Health Reform Agreement 2020-21 to 2024-25 requires the Administrator to publish additional information in the compliance reports.

The format of the Quarterly Compliance Reports follows a standard structure, with relevant data requirements reflected in each quarter. Further information on requirements can be found in the Administrator's 2020-21 Data Compliance Policy.

Executive Summary

The postponement of the Federal Budget 2020-21 due to the COVID-19 pandemic has also seen a deferral in State and Territory budgets, resulting in the delay of 2020-21 Service Agreements between States and Territories and Local Hospital Networks. Whilst it is noted in the September 2020 Quarterly Compliance Report that the majority of 2020-21 Service Agreements have not been submitted to the Administrator, it is acknowledged that the quality and timeliness of submissions has improved over time.

Monthly reporting submissions for September 2020 have also improved with 7 out of 8 States and Territories submitting reports before or on the due date of the 15th of October, with an average submission time of 14.6 days, compared to 28.4 days in the prior year.

The reconciliation submissions for the 2019-20 year have not improved on the prior year with 87.5% of Submission A and 62.5% of Submission B submitted on time from States and Territories, compared to 100% in the prior year for both submissions. Statements of Assurance accompanied 5 out of 9 submissions, compared to 8 out of 9 in the prior year (including the Commonwealth).


